Over the term, we will be helping children with the important transition. The children will be spending more time in F2 over the term to help to familiarise them all with the surroundings. I will also keep you posted on providing a "PE kit" so they get use to changing in the school environment, this will be more in Summer 2 so more details to follow (it will be a change of clothes not the school PE kit so please don't buy anything especially for this.).

As we are hoping to be outside area even more this term, it is essential that your child is ready for the weather. On hot days, they should always bring a hat and applying sun cream before they come to school is advisable. We would also request they have a coat at school for those unexpected rain showers. A light water proof will be fine for this purpose.

We would like to encourage you to inform us of anything that your child does at home that is significant in all aspects of their learning, particularly if it is something that they may not do at school. This may include progress in any clubs that they attend, something that they have learnt to do independently, visits to interesting places or any maths or literacy that they do independently at home. If you let us know about it via Tapestry we can use them to help inform our judgments. Summer 1 we are talking about hobbies and pastimes so please update me of any clubs they attend so we can talk about these and potentially show us some Tapestry videos or demonstrations in class
