Curriculum

Reading

Homework

Homework will continue to be set on Fridays, and be due in on Wednesdays. Your child will receive a new learning log for our new topic. If there is not a new homework sheet stuck in your child's book, this means that they have been asked choose an activity from the learning log to complete.

Library

Our library day continues to be Monday, and children must bring in their books every week. They will be able to renew them if they have not finished reading them yet.

PE

Our PE lessons will continue to take place on Wednesdays and Fridays. We will be remaining inside this half-term, however it is useful for children to still have their full outdoor kit in school in case they need a change of clothes at any point.

much as possible, so please ensure that your child comes to school wearing weather appropriate coats, hats, scarf, gloves etc.
