PLAYGROUND LEADERS

- Remember when they are on duty and turn up promptly.
- Call upon an adult straight away if any rules are broken or if there is an injury.
- Let staff know if any issues arise with the playground or new rules should be applied.

Pupils will -

- Go on the playground as a class for a week at a time so everybody gets a go and there are fewer children on the equipment at once.
- Observe all the rules or will not be able to go on the equipment until it is next their class's turn.
