Dear Parents,

We are now entering the final half term before the children leave Weston Turville School and begin a new chapter in their lives. We do not know where the time has gone but we are looking forward to a very fun-filled and busy last half term in Year 6!

May we take this opportunity to say how proud we were of the children during SATs week. The test papers were challenging, but the children were all calm, focused and they gave their very best. The children thoroughly deserved their picnic; thank you so much for the generous food donations.

Now that SATs are finished, we will be getting ready for certain events that result in timetable changes, these include practising for the end of year production, Business Enterprise week and the Leavers Assembly. We have explained to the children that their learning will still be continuing alongside preparation for these events.

Year 6 PE will continue to take place on Tuesday and Friday. We are intending on being outside for most PE lessons, so please make sure your child has taken hay fever medication, if they need it. On particularly hot days, please apply sunscreen before school and make sure your child always has a refillable water bottle. We do have a bottle of sunscreen in the classroom for children to use to top themselves up.

Our PSHE/Science topic for this half term is 'Changing and Growing Up'. This will include lessons on puberty, change and independence, healthy relationships and how a baby is made. These sessions will be taught each week by the Class 6 teachers on Tuesdays, starting on 16th June. The first two sessions on Puberty are compulsory whereas the 'How a Baby is Made' session is not.
