Dear Parents,

Welcome back for the final term of the infants! We hope you and your children had a chance to relax over the break and enjoyed the hot weather!!

Curriculum

Our topic this half term continues to be a Science focus - Nature Detectives.

In English we will be looking at poetry, Flat Stanley and writing non chronological reports.

Our Geography topic is Kenya, which I am sure the children will enjoy.

Alongside our topic work we will be following the usual Little Wandle Phonics and White Rose Maths curriculum for Year 2.

Library

Our library day continues to be Monday- please ensure that your child brings in their Library book each Monday, as they will need to renew their books if they have not yet finished them.

Reading

We can not stress the importance of reading as regularly as possible at home with your child. If your children are reading the phonics books, we recommend reading the book 3 times at home. This will develop fluency and confidence.

PE

We will be preparing for the Sports Day this term and will be spending as many sessions outside as the weather permits. Please make sure your child has a full kit, including a jumper or tracksuit bottoms/ leggings for slightly chillier days. *Children should have their PE kits in school every day, as we often use trainers outside of PE lessons, and it is always useful for children to have a change of clothes.* Please ensure all children have a water bottle in school.

Sunny Weather

As we are now entering a period of glorious sunny weather, please be mindful of sun safety and ensure that your child comes into school wearing sun cream and with an appropriate hat. We are hoping to do lots of our learning outside! The class have already done some work on sun safety with Mrs Forster and will be able to tell you lots of ways to keep themselves safe.

Moving Up

Towards the end of this half term, we will begin to gently prepare your children for their transition into Juniors. This will include a moving up session, where your child will visit their new classroom and spend some time getting to know their Year 3 teachers and teaching assistants. If you have any concerns about your child and their transition into Year 3, please do not hesitate to come and talk to us.
