We hope you had a good summer break and would like to welcome you to Class 1.

Class 1 will have PE on **Tuesday and Wednesday**. Please send a **named PE kit** to school for children to keep on their peg for the half term - this prevents them forgetting it each week. If you could provide your child with a navy or black jumper and/or navy or black jogging bottoms it may be beneficial. Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings are covered/removed on these days.

Although the library will not be open for children to visit, a selection of books will be available in each classroom for them to choose from so please ensure books are in school every **Tuesday**.

This year your child will again be bringing home reading books. We will provide a book list; please tick and date this **twice** for each book - we will only change books when they have been read twice. Due to the Covid restrictions, we would ask you not to send in items for 'show and tell', display or any other toys/items from home.
