We can't believe we are already half way through the school year. We are so excited that we will be able to see you in a few days!

Please can you ensure you send a named water bottle to school every Monday for your child. They can access and fill this freely. Staying hydrated is very important to learning, and is essential as the weather improves.

Books continue to be changed on Mondays and Thursdays. We only change books which have been read at least twice; the only way we know they have been read at home is when a book has been ticked or dated twice. Please can we ask you to ensure you focus on the comprehension aspect of reading as this is an essential skill which all children need to develop, regardless of the level at which they are reading.

We will monitor your child's reading at school and move them up a level when we feel they have achieved the required level of fluency and comprehension in their reading.

PE will continue to be on a **Wednesday** and **Thursday**. Please send a **named** PE kit to school for children to keep on their peg for the half term. They will need an outdoor kit this half term (tracksuit bottoms and trainers), in addition to their indoor kit. Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings are covered/removed on these days. Library will be on a **Tuesday**.

This half term we are beginning our topic of 'Once Upon A Time'. Please see the topic web attached for greater detail of the areas we are going to cover. Obviously we will have a big focus on ensuring the children's wellbeing, and providing lots of opportunities for physical and outdoor learning
