We cannot quite believe we are in the final half term already.

Books continue to be changed on **Mondays and Thursdays**. We only change books which have been read at least twice; the only way we know they have been read at home is when a book has been ticked or dated twice. Please can we ask you to ensure you focus on the comprehension aspect of reading as this is an essential skill when reading.

We will monitor your child's reading at school and move them up a level when we feel they have achieved the required level of fluency in their reading and of comprehension.

Spelling words will be checked on Fridays. The words will be put on google classroom a week in advance to allow your child to practise at home.

PE will be on a **Wednesday and Thursday**. Please send a **named** PE kit to school for children to keep on their peg for the half term. They will need an outdoor kit this half term, in addition to their indoor kit. Please ensure long hair is tied back and earrings are covered/removed on these days. Library will continue on a **Tuesday** each week.

Mrs Pye will continue to cover the class on **Fridays** for the Summer term.

This half term we are beginning our topic of 'Imagine a Story'. Please see the topic web attached for greater detail of the areas we are going to cover. If there are any ideas you may have or items to bring in for display or discussion these would be more than welcome.
